

Islam is a 'Complete way of life' which covers every aspect of life. Islam teaches the best method of performing religious and secular activities in life. It teaches how to achieve ultimate success in this life, as well as the life to come. It provides us with all answers and leaves no doubt in our mind regarding any matters that we may question. Below are some of the reasons why so many people are accepting Islam as their new way of life...

Peace

Islam is to acquire peace through submitting to the will of Allah (Almighty God) and accepting him alone as your lord. It provides much sought-after inner-peace as you live your life according to the will of your Master, the one Almighty God. To exercise peace. Muslims greet each other with the peaceful greeting:

'Asslaamu 'Alaikum Warahmatullahi Wabarakatuhu', meaning 'may peace, mercy and blessings of Almighty God be unto you'.

Practicality of Good Actions

Whilst most religions contain good teachings, Islam goes further by making this a practical part of life. For example Islam not only teaches about the benefits of Charity, but it makes it an obligatory annual practice of every Muslim who is eligible to give 2.5% of their wealth to charity every year.

To show gratitude to Allah (Almighty God) for His blessings and to show compassion towards the poor, it is made obligatory for every Muslim to fast sunrise till sunset to appreciate thirst and hunger; thereby ultimately showing gratitude to Allah (Almighty God) and showing mercy towards the poor.

In a typical day of a Muslim, they stand shoulder to shoulder 5 times a day in congregational prayer removing any form of racial, social or cultural prejudice.

Also to diminish racial discrimination, Muslims of all races annually gather from around the world in an awesome demonstration of Islam's total disregard of insignificant issues like race, social position and nationality. Several million people make the pilgrimage to Makkah (Mecca) from every corner of the globe, providing a unique opportunity of those different nations to meet one another, making it the largest annual gathering in the world.

Modesty, Morality & Respect

Islam demands ultimate modesty and teaches both men and women to live a modest life and to avoid promiscuity. Islam forbids men from treating women as objects of lust. Islam protects women from abuse and mistreatment by teaching them to remain modest in dress and attitude to avoid being lusted upon by men. It demands men to respect Mothers, Sisters, Daughters & Wives of society.

Islam teaches to uphold the highest level of Moral Values & Social Conduct. It teaches Muslims to remain kind, generous, thoughtful, helpful and beneficial to all people and society around which they live and constantly reminds of the punishment and of Allah's (Almighty God's) displeasure at immorality and social misconduct. For example a Muslim is strongly reminded to look after and care for their neighbours regardless of faith, and demands them to be kind and sincere to the extent that if they are hungry and you do not feed them, then you would not be regarded as a true Muslim.

Perfection & Preservation

Islam identifies that anything that is divine from Almighty God must be flawless and perfect, whilst the work of human beings is naturally flawed and cannot be perfect. Therefore if anything is claimed to have been the truth sent by Almighty God, then it must live up to the challenge of remaining flawless and perfect.

The Holy Qur'aan, not only claims to be a revelation sent by Almighty God, but lives up to the challenge of remaining perfect and flawless. The Qur'aan challenges humanity to put it to the test, and since its revelation (1400 years ago), it has never failed. The Qur'aan says:

"Then do they not reflect upon the Qur'aan? If it had been from [any] other than Allah (Almighty God), they would have found within it much contradiction."

Furthermore Allah (Almighty God) has promised to preserve the Holy Qur'aan from any alterations. The Holy Qur'aan remains in the same pristine condition since its revelation, word for word, letter for letter. This in itself is a Miracle as each and every copy of the Qur'aan in the entire world remains exactly the same.

Muslims in England, America, India, Africa, China and around the world read the Qur'aan in Arabic exactly as it was revealed 1400 years ago.

However in comparison, if one was to take 10 people and gather them in a line, then tell the first person a simple message consisting of merely two sentences, and then tell him to pass the message on to the next person, and then onto the next. By the time the 10th person would receive the message, it would no longer remain in the same wording or condition as the original. Whilst this message consisting of only 2 sentences, could not last 10 people in the mere space of minutes, then how extraordinary is the fact the Holy Qur'aan consisting of more than 6000 verses, has lasted 1400 years (and counting), through billions of people, and yet it remains in the same exact condition.

This is one of the many unique aspects which make the Qur'aan unparalleled in its preservation and perfection, compared to any other piece of literature. The Qur'aan confirms it uniqueness and the impossibility of it being the work of a human being by challenging humanity to try and produce a single chapter like it, and yet in 1400 years...no one has been able to.

Proof

Islam believes in providing proof for its authenticity. The Qur'aan teaches human beings to search for the evidence that proves the Qur'aan to be from Allah (Almighty God). It contains many matchless attributes which prove it to the literal word of God, some of these include:

Scientific Facts mentioned in the Qur'aan - The Qur'aan mentions Scientific facts in extreme accurate detail, some of these include:

The Unseen Barrier between Sweet & Salty Water: Scientist have recently discovered that there is an invisible 'barrier' which stops sweet and salty water from mixing. The Qur'aan has mentioned this in Chapter 55, Verses 19-20

Every Living thing is Made of Water: Scientists tell us that all life came from water, as our body is made of 60% water. This has been mentioned in the Qur'aan in Chapter 21, Verse 30

The Stages of Development in the Mother's Womb: Before the Qur'aan was revealed, people believed that the development of a human being in the mother's womb simply consisted of a small tiny baby which simply grew bigger throughout the nine months of pregnancy. However, 1400 years ago the Qur'aan described each stage in extremely accurate detail and perfect order in complete accordance to recent scientific discoveries which were only made in the last fifty years with highly advanced technology. The Qur'aan mentions this in various places including Chapter 23, Verses 12-14

Unparalleled Linguistic Beauty & Precision - The Qur'aan's linguistic beauty and precision shocked and mesmerised the most sophisticated and learned poets of the Arabs, who took pride in their language and made it the trademark of their superiority.
